

Photography Policy

Our event is a space for self-expression, creativity, and community. We want everyone to feel safe and free to be themselves without concern about unwanted exposure. Please respect the following guidelines regarding photography:

General Principles

- **Consent is required.** You must always ask before photographing individuals or small groups. Do not assume consent.
- **Respect privacy.** If someone asks you not to take their photo or requests a photo be deleted, you must honor that request immediately.
- **No wide crowd shots.** Photos that capture large groups without individual consent are not permitted.
- **Take-downs honored.** If anyone requests removal of a posted photo, we will support them in having it taken down.

Restricted Areas

- **No photography in the ploungue.** This is a designated no-camera zone to ensure full comfort and freedom of expression.

Event Photographer

- The event may have an **official event photographer**. Their work will follow the same consent guidelines and will focus on capturing the spirit of the event without compromising individual privacy.

Community Responsibility

- Everyone shares responsibility for maintaining a consent-based culture. If you see photography that disregards consent, please speak up or alert an event volunteer or ranger.
- Remember that photos posted online may have lasting impacts. Please think carefully before sharing.

Disclaimer

While we emphasize consent and enforce these rules, we cannot guarantee that you won't be photographed and by attending you acknowledge that you may appear in photographs taken at the event even without your consent.

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
